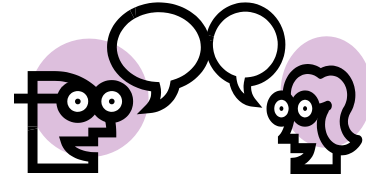


How and When to Interrupt

Looking for *CLUES*

1. **Look** and **listen** for **clues** to find out when it is OK to start talking. One clue to look for and listen is:

- **Is someone already talking?**



2. **WAIT** for the person to **stop talking for 2 seconds...**



3. **After 2 seconds, ask your question or make your comment:**

(Who...? What...? Where...? When...? How...? Why...?)

(I like... I went... I also...)



4. **Another clue is when in class, are other students raising their hands? If so, raise your hand too and **WAIT** to be called on.**



REMEMBER: If someone asks you to stop interrupting, then stop talking and **wait** your turn to talk/ask the question. **Look for clues!**
