How and When to Interrupt Looking for CLUES

1. **Look** and **listen** for **clues** to find out when it is OK to start

talking. One clue to look for and listen is:

Is someone already talking?





2. WAIT for the person to stop talking for 2 seconds...









3. After 2 seconds, ask your question or make your comment:

(Who...? What...? Where...? How...? Why...?)

(I like... I went... I also...)



4. Another clue is when in class, are other students raising their hands? If so, raise your hand too and WAIT to be called on.





REMEMBER: If someone asks you to stop interrupting, then <u>stop</u>

talking and wait your turn to talk/ask the question. Look for clues!
